- School will;**
- Encourage all children to do their best all of the time.
 - Contact home if a child is not in school by 9.30am and there has not been a message.
 - Encourage and reward positive attitudes and good behaviour.
 - Inform parents of their children's progress through meetings and reports.
 - Provide homework opportunities appropriate to children's age and ability.
 - Keep home informed about school activities and special events through newsletters and regular letters home.
 - Keep home informed about the changing school curriculum and how to support children in their learning.
 - Let home know about any concerns or problems that affect their children's work or behaviour and work in partnership with home to identify appropriate support.
 - Ensure that any issues, raised with the parent/carer, are done so in a reasonable, polite and professional manner.

- Home will;**
- Ensure that their child attends school regularly, arrives on time and wears school uniform.
 - Inform school by 9.30am if their child is unable to attend that day.
 - Encourage their child to follow the *Golden Rules*.
 - Support the school's policies and guidelines for consistently good behaviour.
 - Let school know about any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour and work in partnership with school to identify appropriate support.
 - Attend parent meetings and discussions about their child's progress.
 - Support children by ensuring that they have everything they need for their school day.
 - Support their child in homework and other opportunities for home learning.
 - Ensure that any issues, raised with the class or Headteacher, are raised in a reasonable, polite and professional manner.

We listen – We don't interrupt

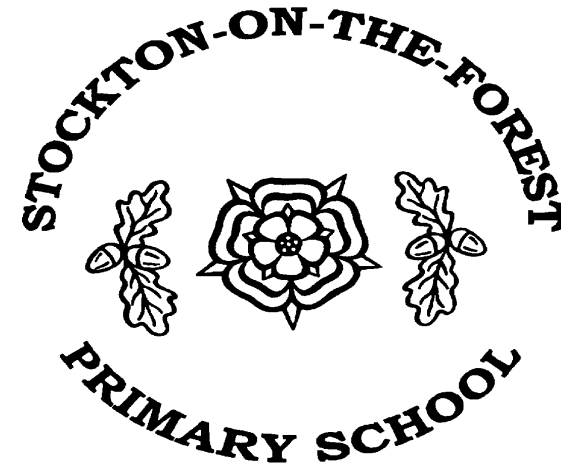
We are honest – We don't cover up the truth
