### UPDATE FOLLOWING STAY AT HOME ORDER

**I am writing to request that you keep your child/children at home from tomorrow, if at all possible.**

The list below sets out a hierarchy of which children are entitled to 'on-site learning' places. I would ask for your support in keeping your child/children at home on days that you do not work or if one partner is available to supervise children in the home.

1. Children who have a child protection plan, who are 'looked-after' children or who are identified as a 'child in need' by either social services or school
2. Children with an EHCP or **significant** SEN need
3. Children adopted from care
4. Young carers
5. Children with **both** parents/carers working in jobs critical to the **frontline** Covid-19 response *or one parent/carer in the case of single parent/carer households*
6. Children with **both** parents/carers working in jobs critical to the Covid-19 response *or one parent/carer in the case of single parent/carer households*
7. Children with special educational needs who are not in receipt of an EHCP but are identified by school as being vulnerable
8. Children with one parent/carer working in a jobs critical to the **frontline** Covid-19 response
9. Children with one parent/carer working in a job critical to the Covid-19 response

Frontline means being unable to carry out your job from home. Your job **MUST BE CRITICAL TO THE COVID-19 RESPONSE.**

Please bear with us as we work out how many on-site places are needed and we organise the logistics of bubbles, school lunches, staffing etc. Please rest assured that both remote and in-school learning will resume and we will continue to do our best to care for and educate your children.

If you think your child/ren qualify for a place and you cannot keep them at home tomorrow, then please send them to school at the same time they attended during the autumn term. Pupils should wear school uniform. School lunch will be provided tomorrow and then we will need to assess the situation going forward.

We may contact you tomorrow to discuss your child's place if our numbers are too large or we may contact you if we think your pupil is entitled to a place that you have not taken.
